

 they come to school on these days with their book bags. If your child's book isn't
 changed on the Wednesday, it will be changed on the Friday.
- PE KIT PE kit can be worn to school instead of uniform, on your child's PE day. Your child's PE day is THURSDAY.
- FRUIT being a 'Healthy School' we promote eating fruit as a playtime snack. Fruit can be either brought in from home, or purchased from school, costing £1 per week.
